In view of the notification received from the Registrar, University of Delhi, dated 9th February 2022, regarding beginning of offline classes for all the undergraduate and post-graduate courses with effect from 17th February 2022, the house deliberated and decided on the following modalities of opening the college in view of the interest of all stakeholders, especially the outstationed students.

- The departments were requested to design a Google form asking all details from the students including their latest mobile phone numbers and the number of covid vaccine doses taken by them along with the proofs. The department should also take undertaking from the students that they shall be abiding by the covid protocol.

- Masks be made available in college premises on payment basis.
