Notice

The college has a presently functioning Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) with an inbuilt mechanism for gender sensitization against sexual harassment. The details regarding the functioning and responsibilities of the ICC are given in Section 4 (1) (c) of the University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015.

Election of three student representatives to the ICC with at least **one male student and one female student** shall be held on **19 October 2023 (Thursday) at 10:30 am in Library reading room.**

This election will be held among the twelve eligible candidates. The list of eligible candidates was already notified on college website on 13th October 2023. The election will be on the basis of preferential voting as per University of Delhi guidelines notified in this regard. The candidate receiving maximum number of votes will be declared elected, provided at least there is one female and one male candidate as per University of Delhi guidelines. If all the three candidates who secured the highest votes in the election turns out to be male students or female students then to ensure at least one female representation and one male representation in the ICC, the votes secured by those three candidates shall be referred to. Amongst the three candidates, whoever secured the third highest number of votes shall be eliminated and in his/her place the female candidate or the male candidate (whichever is applicable) who received the highest number of votes shall be the third student representative to the ICC.

In case of tie, the candidate getting higher percentage in class XII boards shall be declared as elected.

The election result shall be duly notified on the college website. The three students so elected shall serve as student representative in the ICC.

Note: All twelve eligible students should have a copy of their class XII board marksheet on the date of election i.e. on 19 October 2023, needed for verification process.
