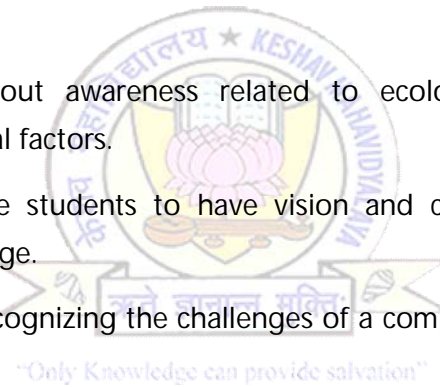

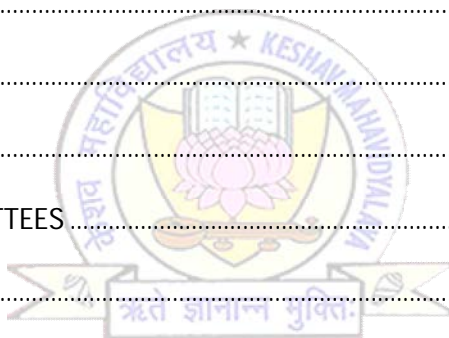

It is my proud privilege to have you all here, I am deeply honoured and humbled by the presence of our Chief Guest and Registrar sir who took time out from their really very very hectic schedule for gracing our occasion. Thanks once again for this honour.

As you all are aware that Keshav Mahavidyalaya is a constituent college of University of Delhi, a premier institution which has a rich legacy of nearly three decades in academic excellence. Our commitment to knowledge embedded in our motto, 'ऋते ज्ञानान्न मुक्ति' (Only Knowledge Can Provide Salvation), continues to shape the journey of our students.

Our college has been accredited with an "A" grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council for its second cycle in 2022. Furthermore, the National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) recognized it as one of India's top 100 colleges. India Today, renowned for its college rankings has identified Keshav Mahavidyalaya in 2022 as one of the "Ten Emerging Colleges" based on a comprehensive study of thousands of institutions. The same thing echoed in India Today Ranking in 2023 recognizing our college as best value for money and being top 10 emerging departments (especially Management studies) that have made a great leap after the year 2000.

Our college offers 9 diverse undergraduate programs across various disciplines, including Science, Commerce, Management Studies, Mathematics, Psychology, and Computer Science. Additionally, the college offers certificate and diploma courses in French and German languages. Keshav Mahavidyalaya also serves as a Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) centre of University of Delhi. With full implementation of EWS reservation and under NEP 2020 curriculum, our current enrolled student strength is 1789, with 1210 males 67.63% & 579 females 32.36%.

Looking ahead, the college aims to enhance opportunities for students by introducing new undergraduate programs such as B.Sc. (H) Chemistry, B.Sc. (H) Operational Research, B.A.

(H) Geography and adding another section to already existing program of management studies as per high demand of students. However, we are awaiting for final approval from the Directorate of Higher Education, Govt of NCT of Delhi.

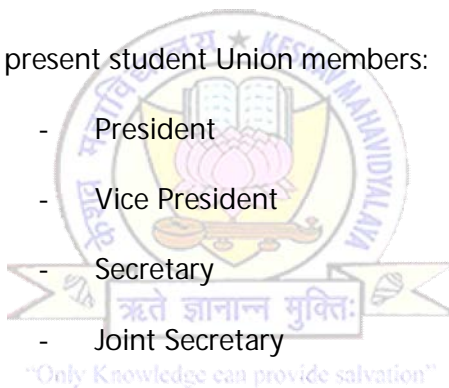

Faculty Achievements

The faculty members have motivated the students towards research. As a result, 2 VI semester students opted for their research paper in the year of 2022-23 and astonishingly a total of 6 students (4 in Electronics and 2 in Physics) opted for their research paper in VI semester in the CBCS mode. With colleges now going in 5th Semester under NEP. I am sure many students shall enjoy the Dissertation paper in their 7th & 8th semester.

Placements Made During Last Two Academic Years

The college's placement cell, Start@KMV, connects students with industries, facilitating their placements. In 2022-23, 31 companies visited the campus for placements. With an average package of 5.1 Lakhs, 94 students secured placements with the highest domestic

package of 8.05 Lakhs. Companies like RSM US, Wipro, and Intellipaat visited the campus. In 2023-24, 44 companies participated, including RSM US, LLP and KPMG. The highest domestic package was 7.5 Lakhs, with an international offer of 10.8 Lakhs. With an average package of 5.42 Lakhs, 90 students found placements, highlighting the college's commitment to preparing industry-ready professionals. Further, a total of 334 online/on-site internships were undertaken by 154 students through Internshala portal in the Academic Year 2023-24 which includes paid and performance-based stipend.

Students' Participation in Departmental Societies

Various departmental societies like **Bizworld** of Department of Commerce, **Blitz** of the Department of Computer Science, **Elektronica** of the Department of Electronics, **Metamorphosis** of the Department of Management Studies, **Modulus** of the Department of Mathematics, **COSMOS** of the Department of Physics, **InPsych** of the Department of Psychology hosted their technical sessions, seminars, talks and various events throughout both the year 2022-23 and 2023-24.

Keshav Mahavidyalaya has been at the forefront of impactful initiatives and events, fostering holistic development and community engagement. EKATHVA, the NSS fest, celebrated creativity and cultural expression, while sessions on entrepreneurship, Mental Health Awareness, Sexual Harassment and Acid Attack prevention and a speaker series

on national progress further enriched the college experience. A separate 5-day workshop on Youth Empowerment and Skills (YES+) was held in collaboration with Har Ghar Dhayan and Art of Living. This advanced program focused on empowering youth through meditation and essential life skills. The college also celebrated National Voter's Day with a Pledge Ceremony, emphasizing civic responsibility and democratic participation. These events reflect the college's commitment to fostering cultural awareness and active citizenship.

Throughout the year, diverse competitions were also organized. These included the NSS-led National Unity Day, Poster Making and Vigilance Awareness Week, Declamation Competitions, promoting unity and anti-corruption efforts. 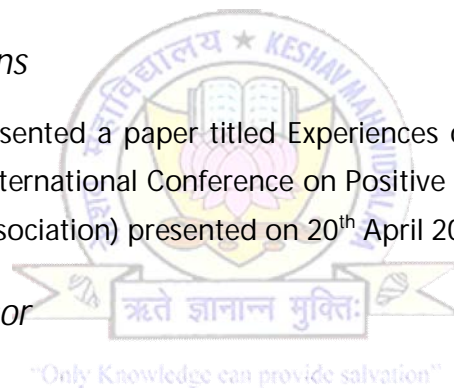

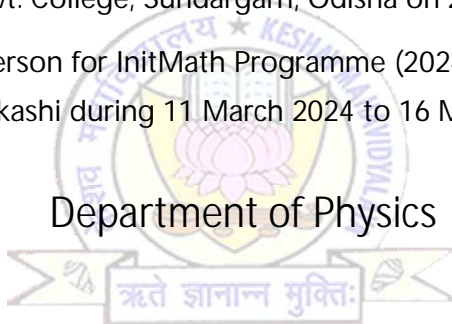

Catering to visually impaired users, the library offers Braille materials and is equipped with a Lez Air Camera Scanner, a laptop with Lex Air VAD software, and Braille and Devnagri software. Furthermore, as a member of N-List Database, the library grants users access to a plethora of e-resources such as e-books and e-journals. Users can reach out for assistance or queries via the library's dedicated email address, "library@keshav.du.ac.in", where the librarian personally addresses their concerns regarding library facilities.
