

# Day 1: Swachhta hi Seva Campaign (September 23, 2019) Presentation competition on Plastic Waste Management and Best out of Waste Competition

The unit organized a presentation competition on plastic waste management and best out of waste competition under the 'Swachhta hi Seva' campaign. The event was judged by Dr. Amanjot Sachdeva (NSS Programme Officer) and Ms. Kritee Manchanda. All the participants presented thought provoking presentations on how plastic is ruining our environment and offered constructive suggestions on the ways to manage use of plastic in our daily life. They highlighted the importance of 3R's (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) towards this end. In the best out of waste

# Session on Plastic Tide Turners Challenge in association with WWF-India and UNEP

On the occasion of 50th NSS Day, the unit organized a session on Plastic Tide **Turners** Challenge in collaboration with **EVS** Department and Eco Club and in association with WWF-INDIA and UNEP. The event was presided over by the Principal Prof. Madhu Pruthi. Mr. Ashish



Rose, Consultant WWF Volunteers, was the resource person. He explained about what single use plastics are and detailed their effects on human beings, animals and environment through his presentation. He also explained how water bodies, animals and birds are being severely affected by eating plastics through short films on the subject. The session was aimed on educating the students about the cutting on our use of single-use disposable plastic and also talked about the negative and disastrous effects of use of plastic in the long run. The Principal Prof. Madhu Pruthi also encouraged the students to get sensitized towards this grave issue and exhorted them to do their bit for protecting the environment. NSS volunteers and other students of the college participated in the session with great zeal.

#### Gandhi Jayanti Celebrations (October 02, 2019)

To mark the celebration of 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi Ji, the unit organised various activities which are as follows:

#### **Plogging**

The unit organized a plog run (picking plastic waste while jogging /walking) from college to nearby area. Plogging as a concept brings together fitness and cleanliness as participants pick up plastic and other waste from road while jogging. The students along with the Prof. Madhu Pruthi (Principal), Dr. Amanjot Sachdeva (NSS Programme Officer) and Dr. Surender Singh (Head, Dept. of Physical Education) covered the area around the college picking up plastic waste covering area near the college, Road no. 42 and near



Bhagwan Mahavir Hospital, Pitampura before circling back to their starting point, all the while emphasising the 3R's - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle through Placards.

#### Awareness drive and pledge

### Daily posters and videos were circulated carrying messages highlighting the following:

- 2. Mode of transmission.
- 3. Practicing good hygiene Importance of Handwashing and its techniques.
- 4. Coughing etiquette and Respiratory Hygiene
